As a composer, sound and media artist, I am keenly focused on exploring the frontier between the acoustic and electronic domains of artistic expression. Much of my work, whether sonic, multi-media, or visual, is informed by a search for organic, intimate connections among traditional artistic materials: acoustic "classical legacy" music, paper scores, electronic and computer-mediated music, sound and noise, as well as experimental score-forms and performance materials, video, projections, photography and various kinds of installations; an abundance of compositional materials to harness and put into service.

The pieces I create explore the nature of music, sound, noise and other media, through the ever mutable relationships that emerge between and among them. It is work that embodies a search for what is possible. I am attracted to investigating "the crevices", both literally and figuratively, searching for combinations and relationships that might otherwise go unnoticed, and bring them into the foreground for closer listening and/or visual consideration.

I relish the challenges inherent in pursuing collaborative work that is *truly* collaborative: works that require participants to engage themselves fully, bringing all skills into a process of co-creation that refuses toleration of petty territorial defensiveness. I also thoroughly enjoy involving myself in work that is self-generated as well as reactive; that is of pure, personal aesthetic vision, in addition to work that is informed by, in dialogue with, or in response *to*, the works of others. In particular, I have found the writings of Joseph Campbell, Denise Levertov and Italo Calvino to be a continual source of challenge and suggestion; works that seduce me to respond through engagement with a compelling variety of artistic media and modes of presentation or performance.

As an educator I am deeply committed to serving others of all ages and levels of experience in their pursuit of musical and artistic excellence. This work is directly informed by my long-standing involvement in a varied art-making practice. Philosophically I am a constructivist educator. My primary goal is to generously support my students in becoming effective thinkers and problem-solvers: to challenge them to be artistically and academically rigorous, to be prepared with a professionally competitive skill set, to be actively engaged, and ultimately responsible for their own life-long education. My role bridges the gap between, and simultaneously exemplifies, the traditional didactic skills of a professor and the more student-centered skills of a facilitator; providing guidelines that help lead them to arrive at and value their own hard-won conclusions. I find this to be incredibly rewarding territory to navigate in this transitional time of rapid change and technological innovation. I am continually challenged and opened by the relentless unfolding of possibility - both pedagogical and artistic.

To say that I simply "embrace" the notion of rapid change in my teaching and compositional practice would be a mischaracterization, since "to embrace" suggests "holding-onto" in an attempt to prevent forward motion, even if just for a while, or else a more casual relationship to the development of a truly organic language of sonic and visual time-art. Quite simply, I am committed to learning, creating and composing from among a diverse set of tools and media available to me in the ever-unfolding present moment - sonic, visual and technological - in an ongoing process of discovery. Only *then* will I continue to have something of relevance to offer my students and others.
